## License Agreement

The enclosed DVDs of “Food For Change,” “Twin Cities Story,” and “Talking to the Wall,” (“the Film or Films”) come with a limited license from Home Planet Pictures, LLC (“HPP”) which gives your cooperative (hereinafter, “you,” “your” or “your co-op”) the right to exhibit and loan out the Films in accordance with the following terms and conditions. You agree to these terms and conditions by accepting delivery of the Films. The additional four films in the 2-DVD set are considered to be in the public domain.

- You may show the Films in public places such as classrooms, libraries, churches and the like.
- The exhibitions shall be related to your co-op in your community and in your geographic vicinity. You may not loan the Films out to other co-ops, start-up co-ops, organizations, or groups.
- You may not charge admission to view the Films or exhibit the Films at events that charge admission in which the Films are shown. Donations that cover reasonable expenses related to showing the Films are fine.
- You may loan out the Films to employees, members, and customers of your co-op to screen in their homes with family and friends so long as they agree that they will not copy the Films or distribute it in any manner.
- This license is not transferable to another institution, organization, company, individual or to any other party.
- You may not copy the DVDs or post the Films or any portion of the Films on the internet. Additional copies can be obtained from HPP. Cost for copies will depend on your level of sponsorship.
- You agree that the Films may not be utilized in any manner other than as specified herein and may not be duplicated, edited, altered, broadcast, exhibited in festivals or theatrically, shown in conferences or summits, transmitted by cable, transmitted on any open or closed circuit system, or otherwise transmitted in digital or analog form, including over the internet, unless agreed to by HPP in writing.
- Nothing herein shall derogate from any rights of HPP, and all rights in the Films are reserved to HPP.
- If you violate any of the terms of this license, HPP shall have the right to terminate the license, effective immediately upon your receipt of written notice of termination, and in such event, you will promptly return to HPP your copies of the Films.

The contents of the Films are protected under copyright and other intellectual property laws. The Films are licensed only for the rights specified in this license agreement. Any use or distribution outside of the scope of this license, including without limitation copying, transmission, alteration or reverse engineering, is strictly prohibited and may result in criminal and/or civil liability.
